Take Action

ELECTED OFFICIALS CITY COUNCILS (CC) & BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS (BOS)

- 1. Put the discussion of a HCD/RHNA lawsuit on your agenda.
- 2. Talk to CC/BOS members from cities that are considering litigation.
- 3. Convene local leaders to explain what's at stake and invite support.
- 4. Designate a CC/BOS rep to speak to attorney Pam Lee.
- 5. Do a cost/benefit analysis for short- and long-term loss or gain.

Take Action

CONSITUENTS COMMUNITY LEADERS

- 1. Organize your neighborhoods and county to learn what's at stake: local control, democracy, voting rights, environment, safety, etc.
- 2. Meet with elected officials to urge the HCD/RHNA lawsuit be explored in support of constituents, not in fear of threats from the state.
- 3. Reject the victims' lament, "There's nothing we can do!" Affirm strength in numbers. Work for what you believe.
- 4. Build momentum for truth and transparency, and a culture of caring.
