## Lobbying

- **Spring Lobby Day** 22 participants in 4 teams w/2 90-minute capacity-building workshops had 15-min. meetings w/26 legislators/aides w/handout re: RHNA, legislation, and risk; w/coverage in 6 media outlets (Leon Huntting, Kathy Indermill, Linda Harmeson)
- October In-District Lobby Week 65 constituents in 11 teams w/4 90-minute capacity-building workshops had 30-min. meetings w/12 legislators w/handout re: HCD/RHNA audit
