ELECTED OFFICIALS

CITY COUNCILS (CC) & BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS (BOS)

1. Put the discussion of a HCD/RHNA lawsuit on your agenda.
2. Talk to CC/BOS members from cities that are exploring or have already signed on to litigation.
3. Convene local leaders to explain what's at stake and invite support.
4. Designate a CC/BOS rep to speak to attorney Pam Lee.
5. Weigh the short-term financial savings of compliance against the long-term expenses of lost property tax revenue, increased and unfunded expenses for infrastructure; and deteriorating trust.

CONSTITUENTS COMMUNITY LEADERS

1. Organize your neighborhoods and county to learn what's at stake: local control, democracy, voting rights, environment, safety, etc.
2. Meet with elected officials to urge the lawsuits be explored in bold support of constituents, not in fear of threats from the state.
3. Reject the lament, "There's nothing we can do!" Affirm courage and the strength in numbers.
4. Build momentum for truth and transparency.
